An Industry Specification Group is a new form of ETSI committee which sits alongside ETSI's existing Technical Organization. Quick to establish, each ISG has a distinct set of rules and procedures detailed in an "Industry Specification Group Agreement".

An ISG enables a group of ETSI members to develop ETSI Group Specifications while using ETSI's world renowned IPR Policy and standardization support tools.

### How to set up an ISG

Four ETSI members are all that is required to establish an ISG. Once an ISG Agreement and Terms of Reference are drafted, the ETSI Director-General can create the ISG.

### Who can take part?

Any ETSI member who signs an ISG Agreement can participate in that ISG. Non-members may attend ISG meetings under certain conditions.

### How much will it cost?

Each ISG benefits from a basic support package, free-of-charge!

## What about IPR?

#### All ISGs use the ETSI IPR Policy.

Each ISG benefits from the world-renowned ETSI IPR policy. Months of expensive legal negotiation are avoided by establishing an ISG instead of an industry forum, and upgrading an ISG to an ETSI Technical Body is so much easier!
