Parking facilities are not available at Ofcom's London premises and a congestion charge is payable for driving a car into central London. We advise not coming to Ofcom by car.

London Bridge station or **London Blackfriars station** (South Entrance) are a 10 minute walk from Ofcom.

To get to **Ofcom** when arriving from:

St Pancras International (Eurostar services)

Walk to **King's Cross St Pancras Underground Station** then take the **Northern line** to **London Bridge Underground Station** (approximate journey time 30 minutes);

Gatwick airport or **Luton** airport

Take a Southbound train on the **Thameslink Railway** to **London Bridge** or **London Blackfriars** station (approximate journey time 1 Hour 15 minutes);

London City airport

Take the **Docklands Light Railway** to **Canning Town DLR Station** then take the **Jubilee line** to **London Bridge Underground Station** (approximate journey time 1 hour);

Heathrow airport

Take the **Heathrow Express** to **London Paddington** station. Take **Bakerloo Line** to **Baker Street Underground Station** then take the **Jubilee Line** to **London Bridge station** (approximate journey time 1 Hour 15 minutes).
