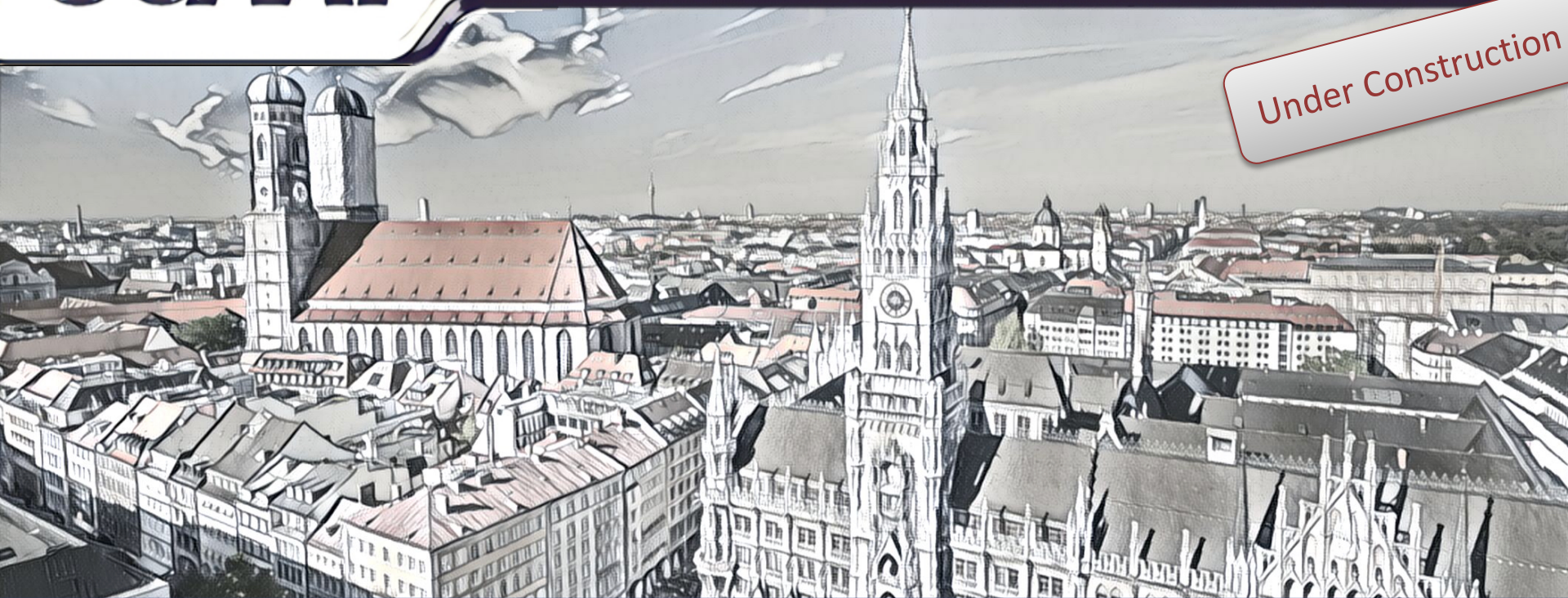

Status Update

## Timeline

- **Finalisation** of Call for Presentations Jan 29<sup>th</sup>
- **Publication** of Call for Presentations Feb 5<sup>th</sup>
  - Website, continuous **promotion**
- **Abstracts submission** deadline ~~Apr 30<sup>th</sup>~~ **May 4<sup>th</sup>**
  - Bidding: May 12<sup>th</sup>, assignments: May 17<sup>th</sup>, decision on format -> virtual
- **Abstracts review** deadline ~~May 28<sup>th</sup>~~ **May 31<sup>st</sup>**
  - PC call: May 31<sup>st</sup>—June 11<sup>th</sup>
- Notification of **acceptance** ~~Jun 4<sup>th</sup>~~ **Jun 11<sup>th</sup>—18<sup>th</sup>**
- **Programme** publication Jun 15<sup>th</sup>
  - Registrations open, **promotion**
- Submission of **final presentations**: Aug 30<sup>th</sup> / ~~Sept 20<sup>th</sup>~~

## Programme and Format

- Discussed different options
  - Settled for 2 days of talks + 1 day of tutorials (no parallel tracks)
  - Live panel discussions every 1-2 sessions (2 chairs + speakers)
- Decisions
  - Submissions: 42
  - Accepted: 22 talks, 7 posters (4 confirmed), 4 tutorials
    - Generally accept with rating above 1.0, reject under 0.5
    - Discuss borderline cases 0.5-1.3 -> 5 additional reviews
  - Keynotes: 2
