The « LREL » offers the same legal value as a classic Registered letter :

- A deposit proof
- A proof of distribution
- **Face to face verification** of the identity of the **recipient** thanks to **IDN** and digital certificates

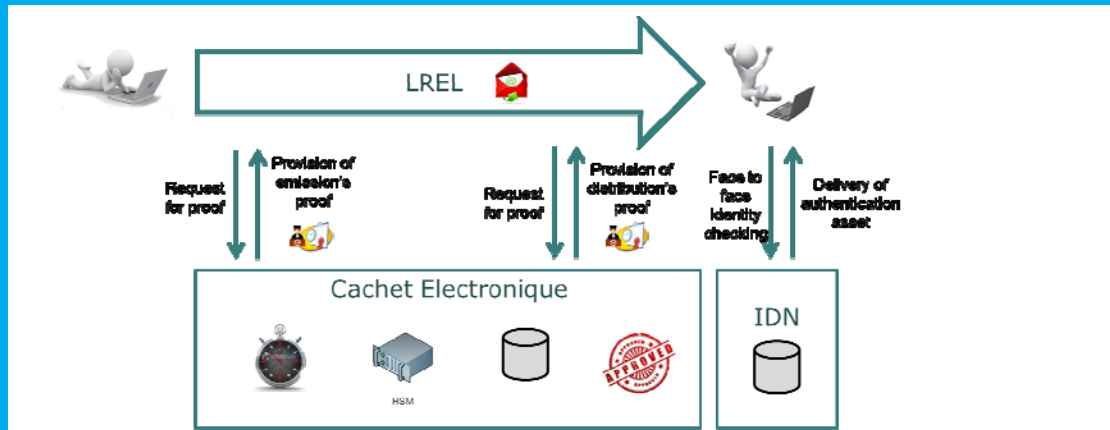
What IDN is ?

IDN is :

- an electronic identity for individual customers
- free and available in 48 hours
- delivered by La Poste with a face to face verification identity

Process :

- Inscription on line : <https://www.idn.laposte.fr/>
- The Postman moves at home and checks your identity
- Your IDN is created

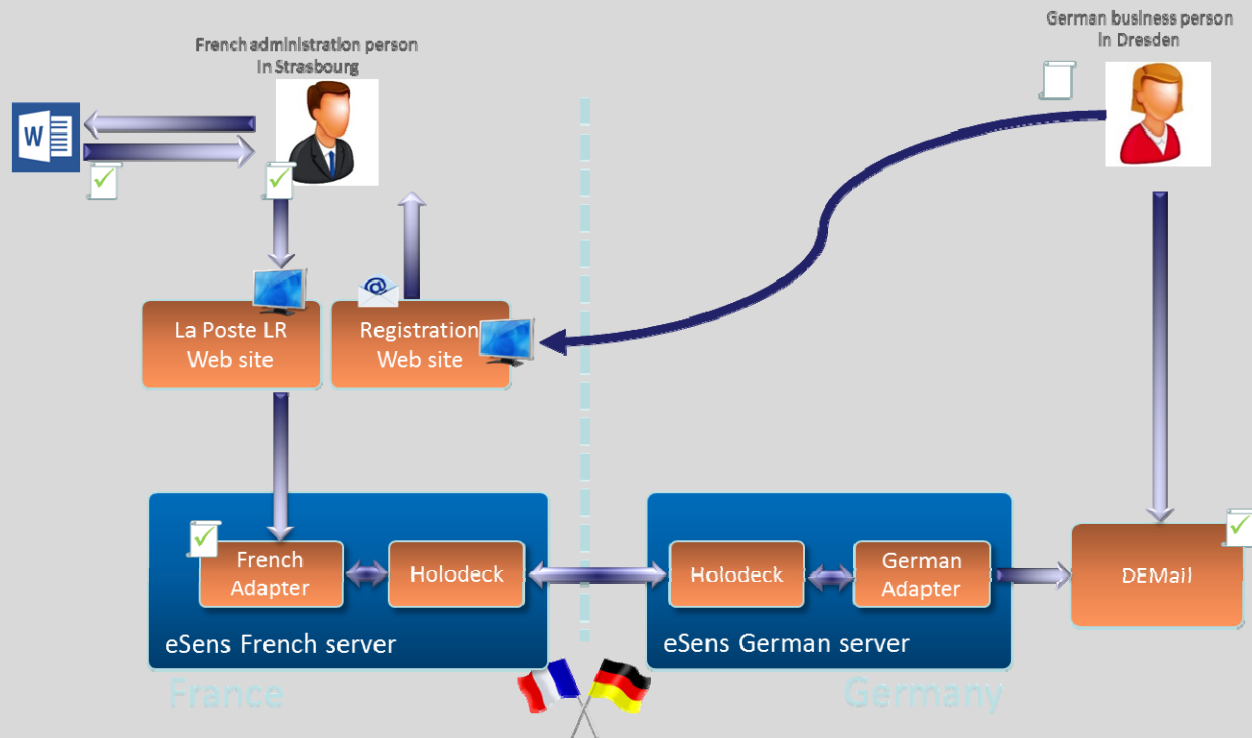




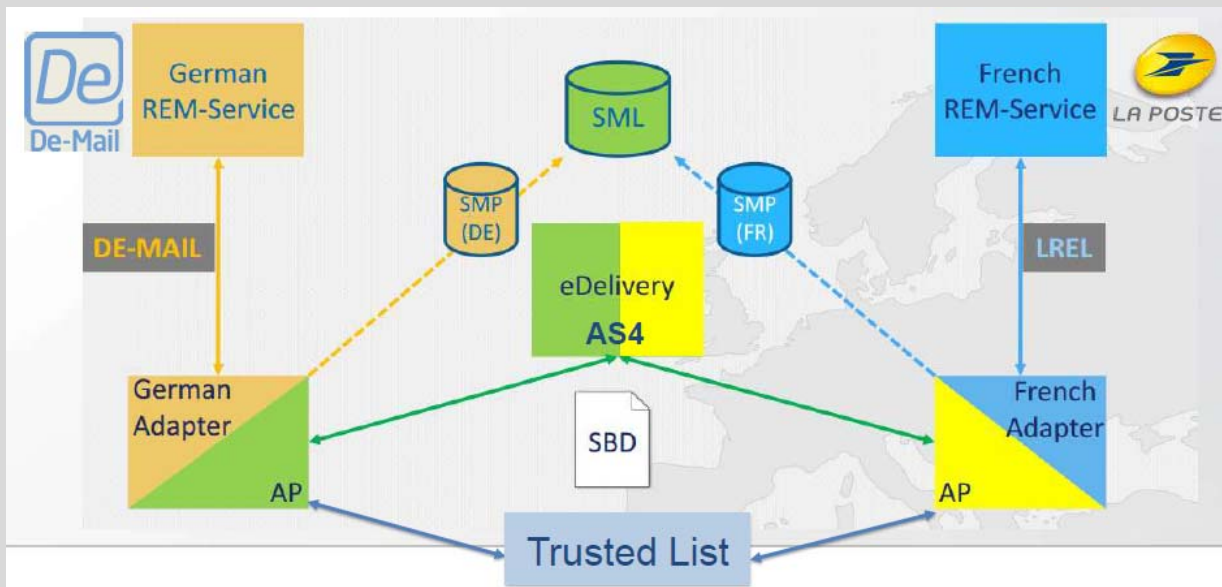
Very early, La Poste was strongly involved in creating favorable conditions for the implementation of solutions to develop cross - border secured exchanges

The French law define some additional requirements that could make interoperability complex :

- **Identity checking of the recipient** (substantial level)
- **Mandatory agreement of the recipient** (before any sending)
