Situation in Europe

- ❖ Co-ordination Group between the three European Standards Organisations
 - ❖ CSCG, MSP Multi Stakeholder Platform

- ❖ Horizon 2020 has a large security element
 - ❖ www.ec.europa.eu/programmes/horizon2020/

- ❖ Many Individual European Country programs
 - ❖ European: UK, Germany, France, Netherlands etc.

Cyber Security Coordination Group (CSCG)

- ❖ Co-ordination Group of the three European Standards Organizations (ESOs) CEN, CENELEC and ETSI
 - ❖ Since December 2011
 - ❖ Together with European Institutions ([ENISA](#), [JRC](#))
 - ❖ Chaired by Dr. Christian Ehler, German MEP
 - ❖ Supported by DIN, Germany



Cyber Security Coordination Group (CSCG)

❖ Terms of Reference

- ❖ To provide strategic advice on Cyber Security to ESOs
- ❖ Analyze and provide joint guidance on Cyber Security Standards
- ❖ Co-ordinate Standards with others (including NIST and USA)



Cyber Security Coordination Group (CSCG)

❖ Current output:

❖ Security white paper

- ❖ Being approved by ESOs

- ❖ Provides input to European Commission activities, includes ESOs proposed roles

- ❖ Mentions proposed method of working, activities



ETSI TC CYBER

- ❖ Created in January 2014
- ❖ 28 supporting organizations!
- ❖ First meeting 27-28 May 2014 at ETSI



ETSI TC CYBER Areas of activity 1/2

❖ Cyber Security

❖ Security of infrastructures, devices, services and protocols

❖ Security tools and techniques to ensure security



ETSI TC CYBER Areas of activity 2/2

- ❖ Security advice, guidance and operational security requirements to users, manufacturers and network and infrastructure operators
- ❖ Creation of security specifications and alignment with work done in other TCs



ETSI TC CYBER role in Europe and beyond

- ❖ Coordinate work in ETSI with external groups such as CSCG in CEN, CENELEC, ENISA
- ❖ Collect and specify Cyber Security requirements from relevant stakeholders
- ❖ Investigate and exploit opportunities of work towards a common strategy with partners and any collaborating entity outside Europe
