It is time now to shift focus from **how to build better N/Ws** to **what to do with N/Ws**.


Softwarization and modularization of Digital technologies is spurring its "democratization" spawning innovations to address local needs and requirements.

As digital infrastructure becomes core for socio-economic growth, concerted efforts are required to address the "Digital Divide". Direct engagement of the "user communities" in global standards dialog is essential for this.


LMLC is an example of local requirements that was incorporated in ITU – and found support from diverse regions beyond the rural and remote – like small island nations etc.

The primary focus should be that community/national expectations should be converted to harmonized global standard that will enable effective deployment and use of networks.

TSDSI approach to Standards Development Lifecycle



- TSDSI lay great emphasis on the 3 phases of standards development.
- Pre Standardization Phase: Stds Driven Research Program, TRIP Forums
- Outreach workshops on Focus Topics
- Partnering with affiliates on topics of mutual interest
